## Organic Innovation Days 2023 with FoodSHIFT 2030 Policy Conference

25 – 26 October 2023, Brussels

The Organic Innovation Days 2023, TP Organics' annual public event and the only EU event on organic and agroecological research and innovation, will take place in Brussels from **25 to 26 October** under the title '**Citizen-driven transformation of European food systems**'. For this year's edition, TP Organics is partnering with [FoodSHIFT 2030](#), a Horizon 2020 project focused on transforming the European food system towards a low-carbon, circular future, including a shift to less meat and more plant-based diets.

**Day 1, 25 October, from 10:00 to 14:00** at BluePoint Brussels, will focus on the [EU Mission "A Soil Deal for Europe"](#) and selected projects and living labs showcasing how organic farming and citizen initiatives can contribute to healthy soils, the basis of long-term food security. Besides key-notes presenting innovative examples, there will be a high-level panel debate with representatives from the European Commission, followed by a discussion with the audience. The day will end with a networking lunch. Members of TP Organics are invited to join the Stakeholder Forum in the afternoon, a space for updates and exchange about recent and future developments and will receive a separate registration link soon.
